

**Outdoor Dining and Music.** At this moment, it appears that we'll be open for outdoor dining with 8 socially-spaced tables as of May 29. We're going to manage this in a new way, and we want you to understand exactly *what* we're doing and *why*.

- **Our issues.** With only 8 tables, we have to be very careful to make sure that we use those tables as efficiently as possible. Also, we can't have people standing around waiting for a table, because that may lead to a lack of social distancing. Because we're Hey Nonny, we want to offer some *live music* as part of your experience.
- **Tickets, Not Reservations.** To succeed here, we're going to sell *tickets* to tables for specific times, rather than take reservations. We'll have specific seating times on our website. You'll pay something for a table for two (\$20 for a prime time table) and then something extra for each additional guest. That not only gets you a great table, but buys you live musical entertainment at every seating. Of course, if the weather makes it impossible to use your table, we'll refund your money.
- **Minimums.** For most seatings there will be some food and beverage minimum per person required. We hate doing it, but with only 8 tables, we have to make sure that we're generating a little revenue and earning our staff some tips.
- **New Procedures.** Of course, we'll have a whole new round of constant sanitizing going on. Our staff will all be in gloves and masks. We will likely institute a temperature-taking regimen. We're also working on ordering without physical menus. It'll be a whole new world!
